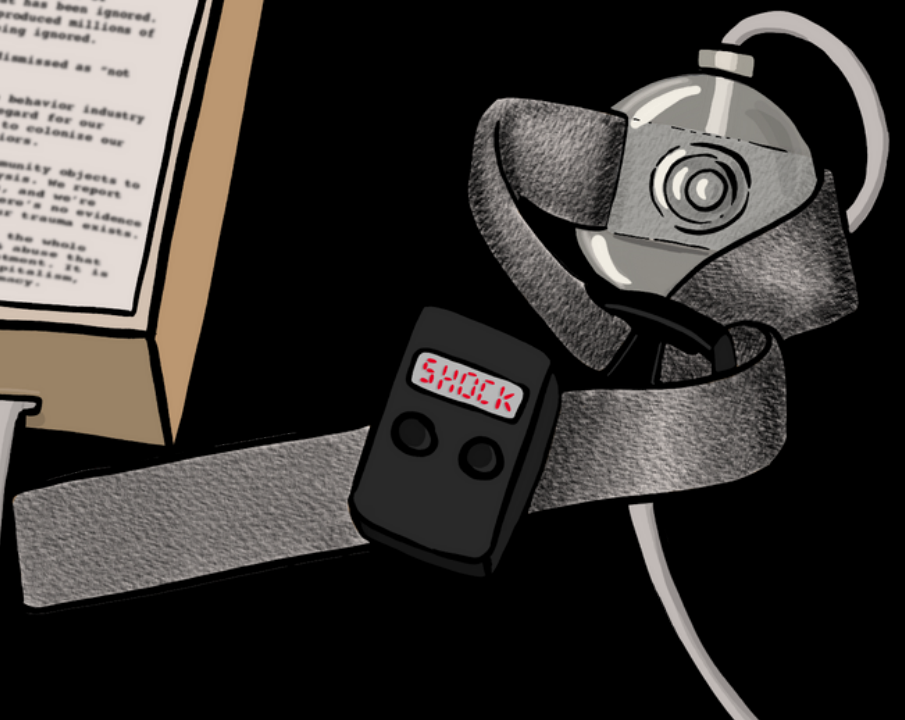

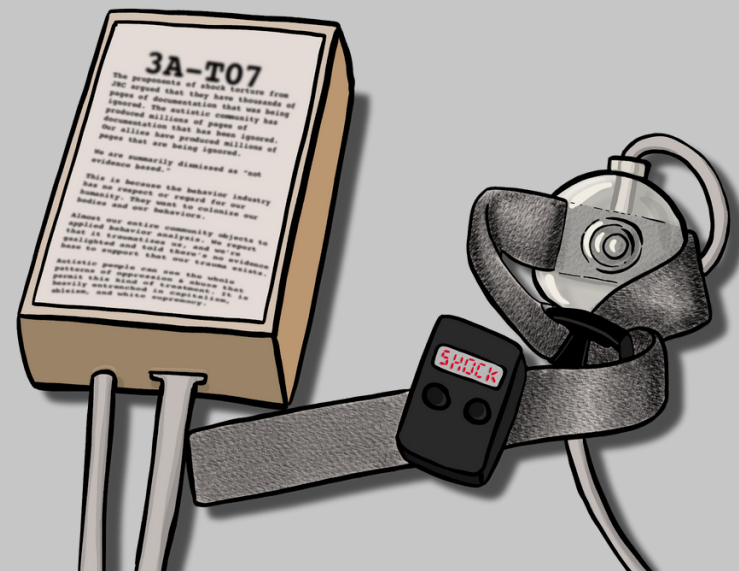

Recommended to be used no more than 2 hours per day

Used 24 hours a day, even during sleep & showers

Vast research showing use causes trauma, anxiety, and aggression

Research mostly conducted by the people paid to use it

In March, 3 adults in New Jersey were arrested for aggravated assault for use on a teen girl

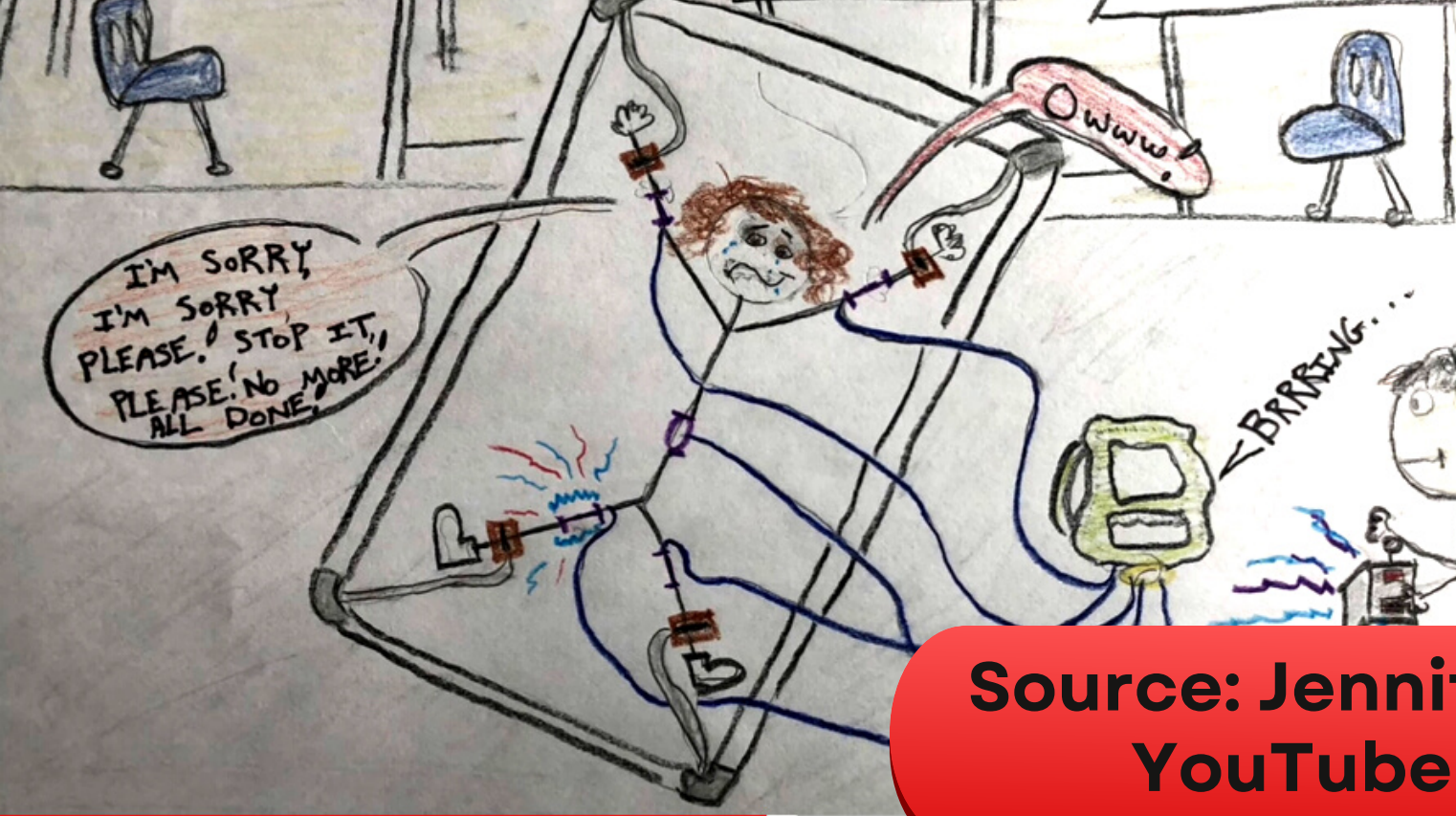


Three women are behind bars in New Jersey this week, accused of punishing a 13-year-old girl by strapping a dog shock collar to her neck.

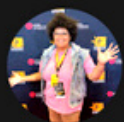
